An expert in his field, Dr. Kim has written seven books, in addition to having co-written numerous published papers and studies, including "Space-time Geometry of Relativistic Particles" and "Poincare Symmetry from Heisenberg's Uncertainty Relations."

Well regarded in his field, Dr. Kim is a member of the American Physical Society. Among his career highlights, he is most proud to have engaged in fascinating research and published his findings for the benefit of his peers. Looking toward the future, Dr. Kim hopes to continue availing himself to the field of physics and finish writing a book regarding Albert Einstein.
